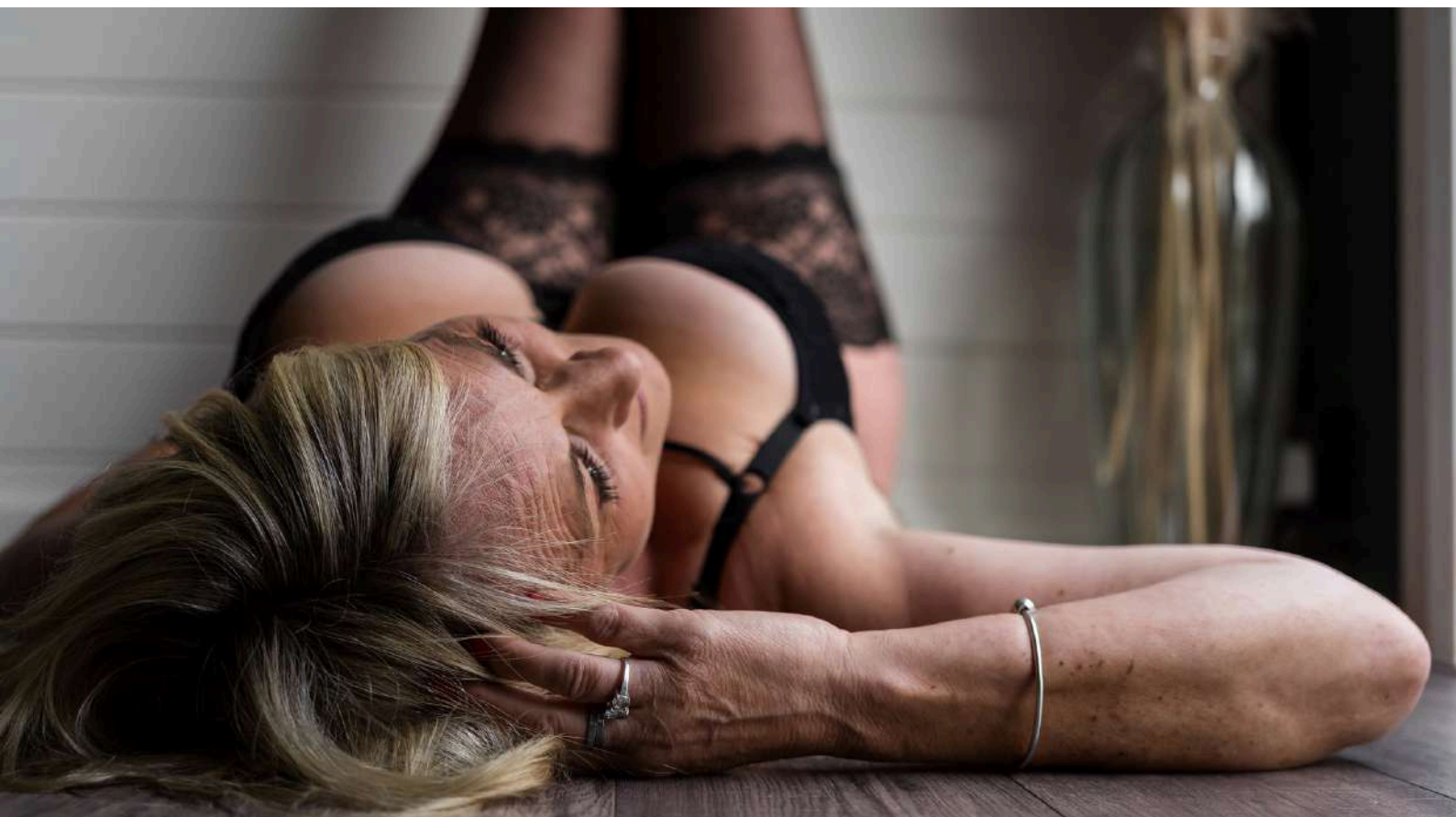




# *Suspender Belt & Stockings*



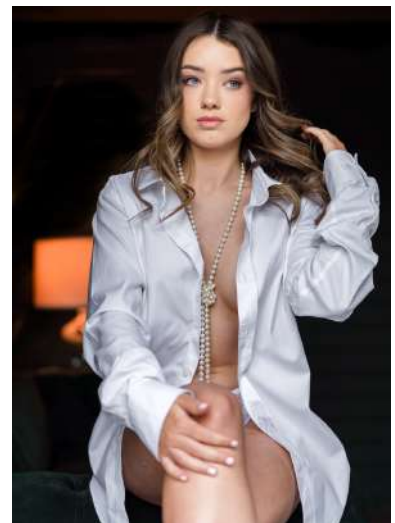
Suspender belts are notoriously difficult to put on but worth it as they are very flattering and, when paired with stockings and high heels, add inches to your legs





# Jewellery

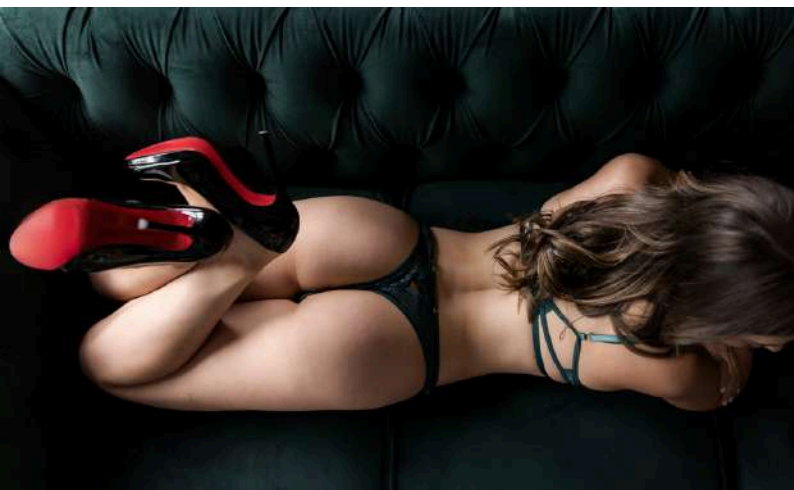
